



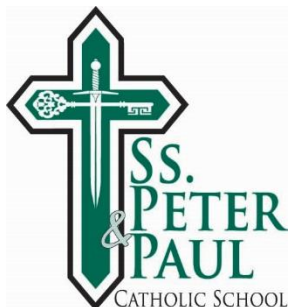

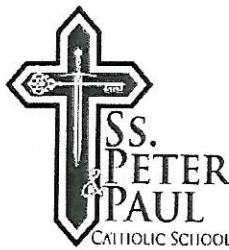

- Show respect for and cooperate with those who actually provide Catholic education and policies: the priests, deacons, parishioners, and all school personnel.
- To meet my financial responsibility by aspiring to the Biblical ideal of tithing, as our Diocesan Synod is considering the goal of all parishioner giving a certain percentage of their income to the parish, and the full participation of the child, according to age and ability, to practice stewardship as well.
